President Harding's visit to Meacham, when he opened the Oregon Trail Highway in 1923, which is now I-84, will be presented also. Marie will give you the Native American view on the early history of Umatilla County, and how it has affected the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation.
